

Goals and Responsibilities of the Long Range Planning Committee

Charges

1. To establish the long range goals of KSRA.
2. To review strategic plan annually. This shall include an evaluation of actions that have been accomplished and what actions need to be on-going tasks.
3. To ensure an alignment of KSRA's organizational goals with the strategic plan.
4. To develop new actions, when appropriate, to promote the organization's goals.

Duties

1. To hold the initial Long Range Planning (LRP) meeting during the summer preceding the first board meeting for the program year. The LRP meeting should not conflict with the annual IRA Leadership meeting and should be scheduled after the IRA Leadership meeting.
2. To hold other LRP Committee meetings at the discretion of the chair of the LRP. These meetings may be held prior to executive board meetings and during the annual conference.
3. To present the strategic plan to the board at the fall meeting for the board's approval.
4. To communicate the approved strategic plan to membership via (1) Website, (2) Keystone Reader, (3) and/or other additional print or electronic media deemed appropriate by the LRP Committee.
5. To rotate the representation of a Regional Director who serves on the LRP Committee based on the region number (e.g., starting with Region #1 in 2010 and then moving to Region 2 the following year). If a Regional Director is unable to attend in his/her year, the next region's director will be asked to serve.
