

TEACHERS AS READERS COMMITTEE

Charges

1. To facilitate interest in the Teachers as Readers concept
2. To develop and share ideas or projects that can be used by local councils to stimulate Teachers as Readers
3. To disseminate a letter and brochure to local council presidents along with other pertinent information to encourage local councils to promote Teachers as Readers
4. To survey council presidents to determine what is currently being done to promote Teachers as Readers and what plans have been incorporated for the year and to conduct a follow-up survey at the end of the year

Duties of the chair

1. To seek volunteers interested in serving on the committee of Teachers as Readers
2. To design a survey and send to all local council presidents
3. To develop ideas to share with local councils
4. To write letters to local council presidents and send the letter with the survey and a list of ideas to promote Teachers as Readers
5. To compile a list of projects and activities completed by councils to encourage Teachers as Readers and to share with members at the board meeting and in the newsletter
6. To prepare an annual report and submit a copy for file with the secretary (Bylaws Article VI, Section 12) and more frequently if requested by the president
