#### Our Rationale

Overall goal -- a meaningful winter event with no need for snow dates

Theme for the year -- CCSS, starting with Dr. Michael Bell's presentation in the fall of 2012

#### So...

- First -- board members tried out an online discussion with a professional article
- Then -- we decided that a book would lead to deeper discussion
- Decision -- we chose a book that was applicable to all grade levels, informative, thoughtful, and reader-friendly

## Logistics - Behind the Scenes

- Decide on a book that is timely, engaging, and available at a reasonable cost
- Select a website, such as GoodReads, for your platform
- Develop a timeline for the discussion

## **Getting Started**

- Publicize and promote the book club
- Hold a face-to-face kickoff meeting
- Follow up with a flier with specific directions on how to participate
- Start the ball rolling with initial responses to the book

## Maintaining Momentum

- E-mail participants periodically to remind them to respond
- Remind participants of where we were on the timeline
- Welcome "out of sequence" responses
- Continue posting and responding to others

### Finishing Up

- Send thank-you notes to participants at end of established timeline, along with survey directions
- Analyze survey results to use for future planning

### Our Next Steps

- Based on feedback and our experience, we plan to do this again next winter
- Spring newsletter included suggested titles as well as request for others
- Include a mix of open-ended and direct questions to spark more discussion
